**The supply of EE mobile voice and data services for
The Peak District National Park Authority (PDNPA)**

In order to provide full transparency with this procurement process through Tendering, this document provides the questions that have been asked by interested parties in relation to the Invitation to Tender (ITT) for the supply of EE mobile voice and data services for The Peak District National Park Authority (PDNPA). The Authority's answers to those questions can also be found below.

Q1)

I am looking at the EE Tender for PDNPA and would like to clarify your requirement if I may. You have said you would like to consider a 100Gb shared data plan. Your usage summary also says the file is missing a handful of SIMs. The usage shows 3 months of billing and in that time you have appeared to use 37Gb which means 12.33Gb per month as an average. Is the request for 100Gb shared therefore realistic? I would have thought 20Gb shared would be much closer to the required amount?

A1)

We are anticipating an increase in the use of mobile data over the next contract period. This may cover only certain teams within the authority, or a much wider set of users dependent upon progress in a few other projects that are intended to increase field based data capture activities. It is for this reason that we have asked for pricing for 1GB, 2GB and a shared pool of 100GB data connections as we can then take the most cost effective solution for ourselves based upon our anticipated usage and the responses received in these tenders.
