Castleton Peak



Marvel at the impressive approach to Peak Cavern by following the stream on historic alleyways. Local traffic on a short section.

Access For All Route:

- (1) Head between the café and shop opposite the visitor centre to meet and follow the stream.
- 2 Turn right at the T-junction to cross the stream by the bridge.
- (3) Turn left immediately after the bridge and follow the stream and path round the front of the houses to Peak Cavern.

Alternative:

Consider exploring underground with a mobility-friendly entrance tour. The path steepens up to the cave entrance.

- Peak Cavern is the largest cave entrance in Britain and was one of the original 16th century Seven Wonders of the Peak.
- Rope makers worked and lived in an underground village at the cave for over five centuries.
- The crag above the cave entrance formed a natural defence for Peveril Castle above.
