Discover a section of Longdendale's long-distance Trans-Pennine Trail enhanced for accessibility with viewing platform and ponds.

## Access For All Route:

- 1 Start at the top of the car park to follow the weaving path up through the memorial wood.
- 2 Go through the gate and turn left onto the trail through the staggered barriers.
- 3 Continue to the viewing platform and ponds, and beyond to where the trail starts to rise.
- The route was part of the first railway line between Manchester and Sheffield. It is now part of the Trans-Pennine Trail from Liverpool to Hull which is itself part of a 2,000 mile route through Europe to Istanbul.
- The phenomena of the Longdendale Lights has attracted a number of sightings and theories in what has become known as the Haunted Valley.
- Torside toilets host the first accessible Changing Place in the National Park.
